If you are not already a member of Forest Oaks, now may be the time to try it out and see if you can make physical activity part of your normal routine. Making time to use any fitness center can be a challenge, so this may be the perfect option for the beginning of your fitness journey!

Memberships are based on whether or not you live within the boundaries of WCID110. Seniors (65+) receive discounted rates. There are no other discounts for membership. All memberships are for a single family in a single residence which include two adults and children under the age of 21. Non-District resident memberships are available. Residents of WCID110 who own their homes can choose to add their monthly membership to their monthly water bill. All other memberships are sold in 3, 6, or 12 month increments and are paid in full at the time of your registration. After your initial membership, you will receive emails from Square about renewals. If you choose not to extend your membership, simply do not renew it through Square. Initial memberships are sold in the office, so check out the District website for more information about the fitness center and memberships. You are also welcome to come and see it for yourself!

MEMBERSHIP RATES

In-District Homeowners: Regular Memberships

- Resident: \$30/month per family
- Senior (65+): \$15/month per family
- Can be paid monthly on water bill or prepaid in 3/6/12 month increments.

In-District Tenants: Temporary Memberships

- Tenant: \$30/month per family
- Senior (65+): \$15/month per family
- Must be prepaid in 3/6/12 month increments.

Out-of-District Memberships: Temporary Memberships

- Temporary: \$60/month per family
- Senior (65+): \$30/month per family
- Must be prepaid in 3/6/12 month increments.

Out-Of-District Tennis Only Membership

- \$30/individual pr month.
- Must be prepaid in 3/6/12 month increments.

WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 19 FROM 6 - 7:30 P.M.


FOREST OAKS CLUBHOUSE




