It is the time we have been anxiously waiting for since March...our new tennis courts are finally completed and our new pickleball courts are lined and ready for use! Our new MUSCO lights are absolutely incrédible and a significant improvement from our old lights. With the new courts and addition of pickleball, we have made some changes to our policies regarding tennis court usage and new pickleball rules and policies. The QR code on the bottom right corner will take you directly to the District website for Tennis and Pickleball Courts and there you will find a full list of all of our policies. We have developed temporary policies so we can see how the court usage shapes up over the coming months so we can address any unforeseen issues. Here are the highlights:

#### General Tennis and Pickleball Policies

- All courts are still first come, first serve.
- All players (tennis or pickleball) should sign-in for court usage.
- Rivera Tennis and tennis league scheduled are all updated on clipboards on the side of the tennis shed and these show all available courts on a daily basis.
- If you don't sign in for a court and start playing and someone does sign in for the court, the player(s) who signed in get it.
- You can also check the online calendar to see what courts are being used on a daily basis but you can't request reservations for walk-in / open play court usage.
- All eight courts are available for tennis use but only courts 7 and 8 (pickleball courts A-D) are available for pickleball.
- If all tennis courts are being used and tennis is being played on 7 and 8, time limits apply to all players. If a tennis court becomes available, tennis players should move to the available court so pickleball players can play.

#### **Pickleball Specific Policies**

- Pickleball is only allowed between 8 a.m. and 9 p.m. daily. Pickleball courts are labeled A, B, C, and D. Pickleball A and B are time limit courts (60 minute max) and C and D are open play / challenge courts (stack paddles for who plays next, winners stay).
- All four pickleball courts have portable nets. If tennis players are using courts 7 and 8, please move the pickleball nets to the side of the courts.
- We do not have paddles or wiffle balls to check out. Players must provide their own equipment.
